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## From the Principal

### CLASS PLACEMENT 2019

Class planning for 2019 is now well on its way with staff and Leadership looking at our numbers, including funding for the new school year. At this point I am pleased to announce that we will be moving forwards with 11 mainstream classes and our 2 Special Classes that we host in our school.

As I have raised in our previous newsletter, student numbers were indicating that we would be forming 10 classes. Numbers have grown allowing for our planning to change towards an 11 class structure. I would like to encourage if you know of families looking for a school to please refer them to come and visit our site.

At this stage our 2019 class structures will be:

- Two Reception /Year 1 Classes
- One Year 1/2 Class
- One Year 2/3 Class
- Two Year 3/4 Classes
- Two Year 4/5 Classes
- Three Year 6/7 Classes

Health and Physical Education, Spanish and Music/Drama will also be offered across the school.

We will soon begin to finalise teacher allocation across the school. Staffing for next year will see Aberfoyle Hub welcome new staff members to our school and farewell some of our current staff members. In our next newsletter I will be better informed to share with you what our staffing will look like.

### Governing Council

All successful schools have a highly active group of parents who support the school in making positive decisions in supporting children to be successful with their learning. Governing Council participation is an enriching experience, one that allows parents

from our community to support teachers, make decisions and share their vision as to the direction of the school. I would like to thank the wonderful group of parents this year who have contributed to our school in such a positive way. The support they have provided throughout the year has been truly amazing. Thank you to all members of Governing Council for your support, guidance and input into a successful 2018 school year.

### Year 7 Transition to High School 2022

Recently, the government has confirmed that Year 7 public school students will be taught in high school from Term 1, 2022. The move will align South Australia's public schools with the national curriculum taught in high schools making it easier to deliver subjects and improve outcomes for students. Access to dedicated facilities and resources and exposure to different teaching styles will also give each Year 7 student opportunities for deeper learning, greater peer interactions, and greater independence and responsibility.
