### Vacation Care Bookings

With the summer holidays fast approaching, Vacation Care Bookings for OSHC are now open! There will be much excitement to be had with activities such as the Mitcham movies, Woodhouse, Big VAC Out (40 bookings max.) and much, more - spaces will fill up fast. Please return forms as soon as possible to secure your desired dates and activities. We urge parents and caregivers to return booking forms by the end of Week 8 to ensure your preferences are met. ### **Policies**

We would like to remind parents that 15 children are required to attend the service in order for the service to open on any given day. OSHC is required to give 5 business days' notice prior to closure on a Pupil Free Day, School Closure Day, or Vacation Care Day. As such, parents are required to give 5 business days' notice for cancellations on a Pupil Free Day, School Closure Day, or Vacation Care Day to ensure minimum numbers are met unless there is a medical exemption. 



### LOST PROPERTY




Please check the lost property bin, classroom areas and general-use areas within the school for any items that may have been misplaced during the term.
