Class Reports

Mobile Phone Policy

All school's in the state this year are required to modify and enact an adjusted or new mobile phone policy by term three of this year. The current State government and the Education Department have requested that Primary school students are not to use a mobile phone at school. All forms of communication are to occur through a child's respective school. The new policy direction also includes Tablets and Smart watches.

Current School Policy at Aberfoyle Hub is, any child coming to school with a phone have been required to hand it up to their teacher. Our current policy reinforces the new directions. There are some circumstances in which an exemption may be requested, however can only be linked to for example, health related matters.

A copy of the new policy will be placed on the school web site for you to access if you wish to.

Behaviour Support Plan

Staff during term two have looked at and revised how we can align our behaviour practices to current training we have engaged in with Berry Street and re-aligning to our school values. A working document has been produced and presented to Governing Council. Ratification of the model has been approved and we are converting the current policy document. One aspect of the Behaviour Support plan is the removal of all blue spots in the school. This will also be formally included in the policy.

Gillian started playing piano at around 6 years old in 1938, being taught by her mother at their home in Mittagong - NSW Southern Highlands. At 9 years old she went to boarding school at Frensham - there was no option to attend as a 'Day Girl' at that stage. She continued piano lessons until the end of school being taught there by Iris de Cairos Rego, who had been a famous pianist in Europe. The family moved to Adelaide where she became a member of the ABC Adelaide Singers for 7 years. It was the only professional ABC choir in Australia and was conducted by the late Patrick Thomas. The Adelaide Singers made many recordings and toured extensively in Rural and Regional Australia, as well as interstate and overseas. She taught piano for many years in her own home and at Primary Schools.

Gillian bought this piano in approximately 1981, second hand from people living at Wonnaminta House in Crafers. In addition to her lifelong commitment to Music and Music Education, she was a Foundation Member/Secretary of Trees for Life. She grew many thousands of seedlings herself and coordinated volunteer growers to grow seedlings to donate to farmers keen on increasing their native tree plantings on farms and in public spaces. Gillian 'just LOVED playing the piano, any piano' and hopes that many children will have the opportunity to share the love by playing this piano.

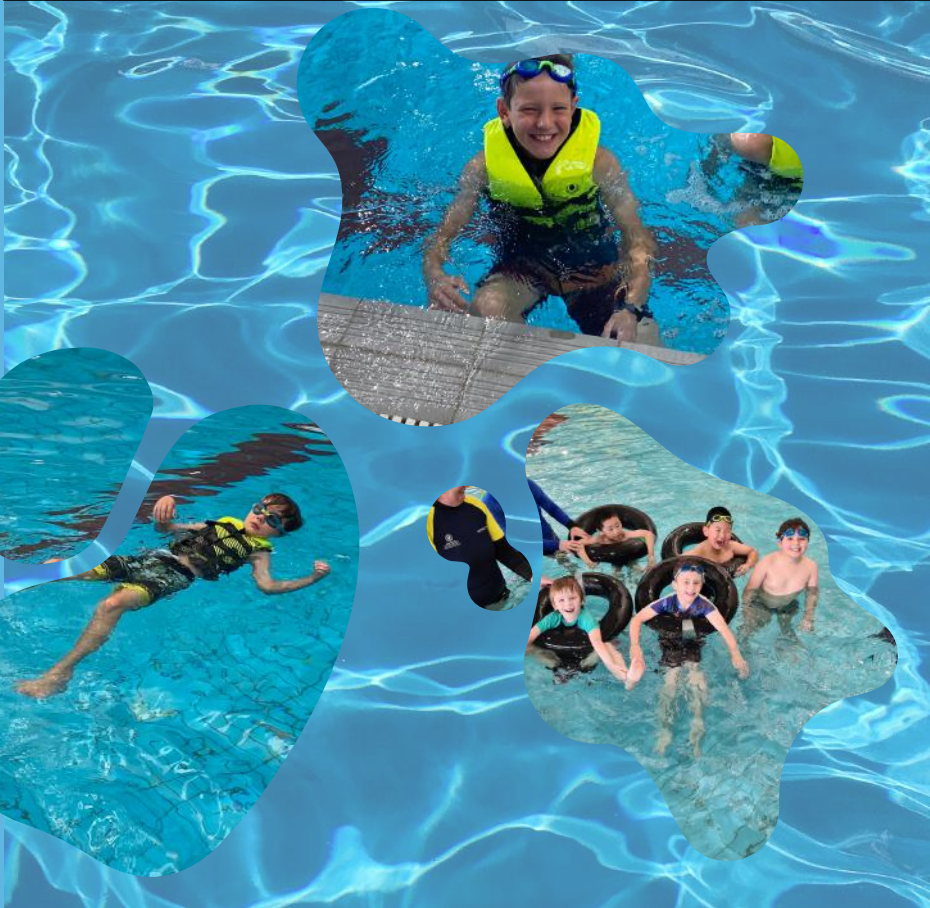
Round 3 Update

- Online orders - do not require an envelope returned to your school

If you miss the online order deadline, you can submit a completed sibling order envelope first thing in the morning of the day of photography, so your school is aware you want the photo taken and can bring your children together in time for it. Sibling photographs only apply to children enrolled at your school. Please note not all schools offer sibling photos
- Late fees - a late fee will be applied to each package purchased after photo day due to the additional cost of producing these packages separately
- Package delivery - photographic packages will be returned to your school for distribution approximately six weeks after photos are taken
- Previous Years' photos - Past years' photographs including sports, co-curricular and representative groups are also available to order under the "previous years or group photo" tabs at your school's advancedorder site when you click on the "Order School Photos Here" button above.
