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### From the Principal

### **Reports**

During week 10 all students will receive their semester one reports. Your child's reports will give you an indication as to how they have settled in to semester one, the successes they have experienced and suggestions of what they can do to further improve on what they have achieved thus far. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher if you have any queries about their report. As per our school policy, you are also able to request early in term three a parent/ teacher interview if you feel you need this for further clarity or to discuss your child's learning goals.

#### **Lost Property**

### Adults on grounds when collecting children

Just a quick reminder at times Parents/ Caregivers will come in to collect children for various reasons. A quick reminder when you do come in please do not walk around the school grounds looking for

your child. We ask that you head to the Front Office, let the office know and we will contact your child's teacher to send him/ her up. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to ring the school and seek further clarification.

### What are WALT and WILF? (Learning goals)

Students at the Aberfoyle Hub have been learning what a WALT is and what is a WILF. **WALT** is (We Are Learning To) and **WILF** (What I'm Looking For). These two acronyms were developed as a guide to help teachers identify learning goals and related success criteria at the beginning of each and every lesson. More often than not, teachers do this regardless, but using a visual reminder of your chosen acronyms in the classroom helps both teacher and students make this part of the lesson structure.

WALT (also referred to as 'learning intention') is all about outlining the objectives of the lesson. What will students be learning about? What's the learning goal or aim of the lesson?

For example, a writing lesson goal maybe – use descriptive language to write imaginative texts. WILF (sometimes called 'success criteria') is all about the ingredients the student needs to do, include or focus on in order to fulfil the learning outcome (WALT).

For example, the success criteria for the above writing goal may be – evidence of adjectives, metaphors and extensive vocabulary in their writing.



This year to help celebrate National
Reconciliation Week at Aberfoyle Hub R-7
School students participated in a variety of
activities. The senior students made Jonny
Cakes (a different way to cook damper) and
topped them with bush tucker inspired jams
such as green ant, quandong, Kakadu plum and
bush apple.

It was pleasing to see children being brave and trying something new, as the green ant jam was the one that was tasted the most.

The middle years students engaged in learning about bush tucker (native food plants) and planted them in dedicated parts of the school yard.

The early years children were involved in Yoga Dreaming where Kathryn Bullock, an Aboriginal woman came to do a session of Aboriginal Inspired Yoga - called Wayapa. The children were taught movements that were linked to 11 different elements of the earth. It was very calming while learning culture and moving our bodies.

All activities helped us engage with Aboriginal culture to show respect and acknowledge the First Nations People of Australia. We all spoke about how and why we should keep moving forward together.
