Secondary School Enrolment Offers

This term enrolment offers for secondary school will be sent to the families of our year 6 and 7 students. It is important for you to know that not all schools will send out their enrolment offers at the same time, but they will be sent as close as possible to 13 August 2021.

Most families will receive their offer via email. If you think you have not received your enrolment offer from your secondary school, you need to check your junk folder for an email from education.noreply@sa.gov.au.

If you did not provide an email address on your Registration of Interest form, you will receive your enrolment offer in the mail or it will be handed to you by your child.

If your enrolment offer has not arrived by 18 August, please let the Front Office know and we can follow up with the secondary school on your behalf.

If you need support to accept your enrolment offer, it is best to contact your allocated secondary school and they can step you through the process.

Attendance

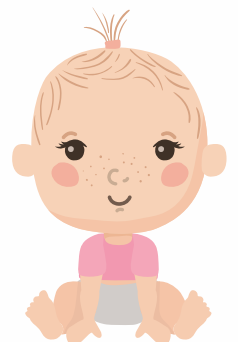

Pre-Service Teachers

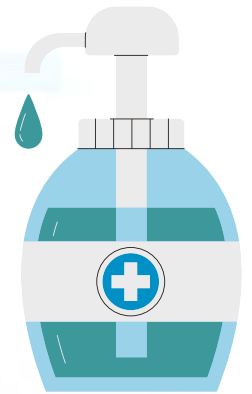

SA contact tracing and exposure locations



South Australia – Health alert

If you attended an exposure location, you are required to follow the relevant health advice under the [Emergency Management \(COVID-19\) \(Exposure Site Requirements No 2\) Direction 2021](#).

If you receive an SMS from SA Health identifying that you were at an exposure location, you must follow the relevant health advice and complete the online form, if requested.

You may not always receive a call, SMS or email from SA Health. You must follow the relevant health advice even if you have not been contacted.

If you were at one of the below locations, but not at the specified date and time, monitor yourself for symptoms and get tested as soon as they develop.

Illness Reminder

Please do not send sick children with cold or flu type symptoms to school. If your child has had gastro, they must be kept home for 24 hours after their last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.

If you're unwell, get tested

People who have any of the symptoms below, even if mild, should get tested for COVID-19 as soon as symptoms appear:

- fever or chills
- cough
- sore throat
- runny nose
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell
- diarrhoea and vomiting.

The latest catalogue (issue 5) has been sent home via classrooms. **Please note:** catalogues are **for reference only** - orders should **not** be written on them).

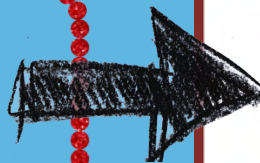
Book Club books will be distributed to students via class teachers.
