





Where can I park?

Students need to return their Reading Record this week that parents have been asked to complete each time your child reads to you.

Reading is good for you because it improves your focus, memory, empathy and communication skills. Reading allows you to learn new things to help you succeed in your work and relationships.

The fair will run from 10th August to 15th August in the library.


Families will be able to purchase books before school, after school and online.
