2025 MATERIALS & SERVICE CHARGES AND COMMUNITY MEETING INVITATION

Our Governing Council have proposed the Materials and Services charge next year be set at \$355 per student. This will allow us to maintain our learning programmes. A copy of the watermark notice detailing the itemised breakdown of the charge can be seen in the adjacent image.

The commitment by the state Government of South Australia to support all student fees by offering a \$200 rebate to full paying families means that families will only be paying \$150 per student in 2025.

As per communication sent out last term all parents/caregivers of Reception to Year 5 students who are responsible for the charge are invited to attend the next Governing Council meeting on Wednesday November 6th at 6.30pm to discuss the proposed increase of the 2025 Materials and Service Charge to \$355.

After the community meeting, Governing Council will decide if the full amount of \$355 will be the 'legally recoverable' amount. If accepted the polling letters will be sent to parents/carers to approve the amount as a 'legally recoverable' amount. #### Being offered include;


- Basketball (turning 8 or above in 2025),




