From the Principal by Sarah Magnusson

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our recent pupil free day was spent with Dr Sarah McDonagh continuing on with our learning on reading. During the day student achievement and growth across was acknowledged and celebrated. Time was also spent for consolidation of our teaching and learning in reading fluency, daily reviews and reading groups. Student engagement strategies were also reviewed to ensure students are actively engaged during these lessons. This year's area of focus is to look further strategies to increase reading comprehension with our students. Sarah McDonagh spoke to us about the importance of increasing general knowledge, vocabulary and fluency within our reading fluency, reading instruction groups and daily review lessons. Teachers will be including reading passages and vocabulary related to topics within other subject areas being taught.

STUDENT LED CONFERENCES

Student led conferences of up to 15 minutes duration will be held during Weeks 10 of this term. (Class teachers will be sending out interview time slot request forms soon.) Student Led Conferences will be held from Monday 31st March to Monday 7th April. Tuesday, April 1st will be the common night in which all staff will be available for appointments upon requests. This is inclusive of our Specialist Teachers – Helen Nicholas, Rachael Mitchell and Brad Walters will be available for appointments upon request on this night.

EMS TRANSITION

Our school administration and finance system is being updated in the coming weeks.

All Department for Education Schools are transitioning to a brand-new system - Education Management System (EMS), replacing the current EDSAS system.

Over 200 schools across South Australia have already transitioned and our school staff have been undergoing training over the past few weeks in readiness for the transition at Aberfoyle Hub Primary School. What does this mean for our community? Due to the transition to EMS, you have not received your Material & Services Fee for 2025. Extra time will be added to the due date once the transition has occurred. Invoices will be sent home in end of this term, however, if you are eligible for school card, you can submit you application online at any time. School Card must be applied for every year.

There will also be some disruptions over the coming weeks that may delay some administrative and finance tasks. We will do everything we can to keep this to a minimum. From Monday 17th March, the finance system will start the transition to EMS. This will run from 21/03/2025 to 24/03/2025.

During this period, no financial transactions can be processed. Then from 4pm Thursday 20th March until our 'go live' day of the 24/3/2025 the administration system will be 'frozen' for any new transactions, meaning our school admin team will have limited access.

We ask for your patience moving forward, firstly with the transition periods as listed and then with our team learning the new system.

SCHOOL FEES

Materials and Services Charge

Tax Invoices for the 2025 Materials and Services Charge will be distributed to families (via class teachers to students). The package includes an invoice, an information letter and an agreement form for payment by instalments.

Payments by instalments form is optional for those who prefer to pay in smaller amounts. Please contact us if you do not receive the package from your child or if you'd like to speak to us regarding payment plans/difficulties.

Families who still have outstanding fees for 2024 will soon receive soon a Final Notice. The fees are legally recoverable and will be forward to the Dept. for Education Debt Recovery Unit.

Please note: A new school card application must be submitted every year.
